Commented [CP5]: Even if there were other elements of the project that you did not include here, I recommend omitting 'etc.' because it gives an impression of imprecision and informality.

Commented [CP6]: This was somewhat confusing. Did you mean that you standardised the development process by adding the extra features to it? If so, I believe the change from 'with' to 'by including' makes this clearer. If this is not what you meant, please contact me. I would be glad to discuss this part of your CV in more depth to propose alternative phrasing.
